ROUND ROBIN RULES OF PLAY

- 1.) Continuous Play
- 2.) Coin toss determines the home team. The home team will list their line up first, and then start the first game. Loser starts thereafter
- 3.) The loser of the last game in the match has the option of starting the diddle. The winner of the diddle has the option of starting the last game. All 8 players play the last match.
- 4.) All games must be played in round robin. (if not you could be subject to be out of the tournament for 2 years.)
- 5.) Tie-breakers are head-head (all teams)

IF STILL TIED

01 will be 701 stacked first to go out wins

Cricket will be 1 game no score first to close out everything wins.

Applies For All Diddling.

DIDLING: When diddling, the dart that is closest to the center will determine the winning dart. You may continue throwing until one dart sticks in the target. If the first player hits the center hole in the bull's-eye, the dart will be removed to allow the other player the opportunity to tie.

In the event they are the same distance from the center of the bull's-eye, the players will continue diddling and reverse the order until a winner is determined. The darts will remain in the board.
